Oral Free Communications

The Organising and Scientific Committees cordialy invite all those involved in any aspect of the congress related topics to participate actively by submitting abstracts, either for oral (or video) presentation or poster.

The best abstracts will be selected and integrated as presentation during the congress. Authors may indicate their preference for an oral or video presentation. However, as only a limited number of oral communications can be accepted, authors may be asked to change their proposal and present their work as a poster.

Video Presentations

Authors can submit an abstract for video presentation. The best videos will be integrated in the program. The abstract should describe in brief the content of the video.

Poster Presentations

Poster presentations will carry equivalent scientific status to oral communications in the program. Instructions for poster preparation and display will be given at the time of notification of acceptance. Poster exhibition will be held at the Jubileumzaal in the first floor of the venue.
